What's Our Mission?

The PTF exists as a service organization of BCCA parents, teachers and administration to provide fun activities for our families, to enhance our experiences at BCCA and to function as a teacher support group.

What's the Board?

The "Board" consists of a few positions (President, VP, Treasurer, Secretary, Volunteer Coordinator, Home Room Mom Coordinator). We meet and communicate regularly with school administration and teachers. We also meet monthly to plan events and discuss how we can better support the entire staff. We publish a quarterly newsletter for the school community detailing on-going projects as well as updates on our fundraisers.

SAF

The SAF Fund (Staff Appreciation Fund), a one-time \$25 donation per child, provides gifts for teachers and staff at special times throughout the year for birthdays, Christmas and Teacher Appreciation Week.
